A group of mountains in Eastern Tennessee



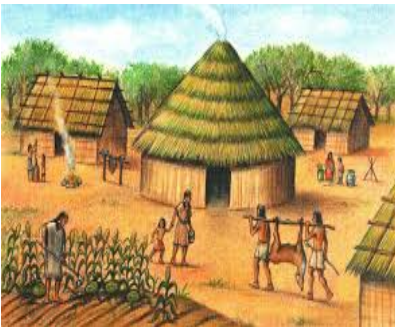
ancestors
