<u>Goal</u>

In response to a prompt students will write a complete paragraph with an opening and closing sentence. (Students are writing independently.)

#### Scaffold

Teacher modeling of using prompt language to respond to a prompt. Teacher modeling of answering ALL parts of a question or multiple questions in a given prompt with evidence. Students should already have paragraph format foundation for writing by now.

- Accuracy in grammar, spelling, punctuation and capitalization


<u>Details:</u>
