


volcano

a landform from which molten lava erupts through the surface

mountain


a landform that rises high above the surrounding land



Earth's Surface Week 2

valley

a long depression or ditch in earth's surface, usually between mountains or hills





to force out or release something suddenly (like lava)






basalt

rock formed from cooled lava

sediment

solid material that is moved and deposited in a new location

contract


to shrink

splash erosion

erosion caused by the impact of falling raindrops



runoff

water that flows over the surface of the land

saturate


to cause something to be fully soaked to the point where it can't take on anything more

current


a steady flow of water



Earth's Surface Week 2

boulder

a very large rock



arch

a curved shape that spans an opening

coast

the area where the land and sea meet

pebbles

small, smooth rounded stones

sea stack

a column of rock standing in the sea, remaining after erosion of cliffs.

iceberg

a large floating mass of ice
