# steeple

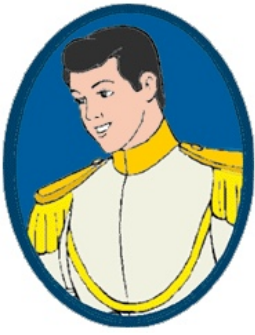
a tall tower, usually on top of a church or temple

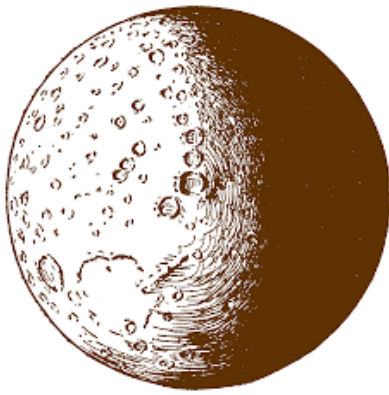
# peace
